





More than two-thirds of the world's millionaires are affiliated with a religion. Of the 13.1 million millionaires in the world:

56.2% are Christian

6.5% are Muslim

3.9% are Hindu


1.7% are Jewish

If you look around you will see there are a lot of very wealthy religions/religious believers.




Are wealthy religious people hypocrites?




How much is the Vatican worth?






<u>Antilia</u>


Antilia is the second most expensive house in the world and is worth about £1.5 billion.
